- Create RESTful APIs and microservices using PHP (Laravel) and Node.js (for invoice management).
- Configure and optimize MySQL databases.

Infrastructure Management and DevOps

- Administer, maintain, and monitor Linux-based servers.
- Deploy and manage cloud infrastructure on AWS (EC2, S3).

Support and Maintenance

- Monitor systems and address issues promptly.
- Provide technical support and implement feature updates.

Security and Version Control

- Manage version control using GitLab.
- Implement security measures, including encryption, authentication, and vulnerability testing.

Agile Methodologies and Project Management

- Work within Agile frameworks (Scrum or Kanban) to manage tasks and sprints.
- Participate in weekly or bi-weekly project follow-ups to ensure alignment with objectives.
- Address user system requests and resolve technical issues.

External API Integration
